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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

There will be a public hearing held on a proposed amendment to the Community Development Ordinance (CDO), **File No. 1-TA-21 – Modifications to the Community Development Ordinance**, brought before the Planning Commission on December 13, 2021, at 7:00PM at the City Council Chambers in the City Hall Annex Building at 500 Klamath Avenue, Klamath Falls, OR 97601.

The City of Klamath Falls is proposing to amend the CDO to comply with recently issued State mandates related to housing, to bring the code into compliance with other existing State statutes, to add missing criteria to certain land use actions, and to correct text errors and increase the clarity and usability of the CDO. Additionally, this proposed code update would also address access standards; simplify parking standards; modify certain sign standards; better differentiate medical, government, and social services uses and identify zoning in which those land uses are permitted; restrict large-scale solar farms; and restrict single-family and duplex dwellings from commercial-oriented zones.

The full text of the proposed changes to the CDO is available on the City of Klamath Falls website under **Our City → Committees and Commissions → Planning Commission**. That text and the associated staff report, **1-TA-21**, will also be available for inspection at the Development Services Department, located at 226 S 5th Street, at least 7 calendar days before the date of the hearing. A copy of **1-TA-21** will also be available for purchase at a cost of \$0.25 per page. HOW TO PARTICIPATE OR SUBMIT COMMENTS: Written comments should be directed to Planning Manager Joe Wall, jwall@klamathfalls.city, or submitted during the public hearing on December 13, 2021. Any interested party may testify at the hearing or submit written testimony at or prior to the hearing. Written comments will be accepted until the close of the public hearing. Oral statements and testimony must be given at the public hearing.

Please note that failure to raise an issue during the hearing, in person, or by letter and/or that failure to provide statements or evidence sufficient to afford the hearing body an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to a higher body.
