Eligibility: Any entity or group serving primarily residents of the City of Klamath Falls is eligible to apply for Community Initiative Funding. No request shall exceed \$7,500.

Application: Eligible entities seeking Community Initiative Funding shall submit a completed Community Initiative Funding Application to the office of the City Manager by the due date listed on the website.
