ELLA REDKEY POOL FACILITY & SAFETY RULES

- Lifeguards and Pool Staff are responsible for ensuring the safety of all participants. Failure to adhere to pool rules or arguing with the lifeguards or pool staff will result in immediate removal from the pool and facility.
- Water, drugs, and alcohol do not mix - no person who appears under the influence may use the facility.
- Smoking, drugs, tobacco, vaping, and alcohol are not permitted at the pool facility.
- No running, roughhousing, loud or offensive behavior, language or gestures.
- Everyone must walk on deck and in the locker rooms.
- NO DIVING - Except in designated diving areas.
- Keep all stairs and ladders clear unless using them to enter or exit the water.
- No animals are allowed at the facility, with the exception of service animals.
- Take a cleansing shower before entering the pool or after using the toilet.
- Swimmers who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- No prolonged, competitive or breath-holding games are allowed.
- Immuno-compromised individuals should use caution when using the pool.
- Do not use the pool if you have had diarrhea in the past two weeks or a disease communicable by water.
- No food or drink allowed on the pool deck.
- No glass or plastic containers that can shatter are allowed at the facility. Grills are not permitted.
- All swimmers must wear appropriate swimwear. No jeans or street clothing allowed. Water shoes are permitted.
- Competition blocks are for training or swim meet use only; no general use is allowed.



SUPERVISION & NON-SWIMMERS

- Children 8 and under MUST be accompanied by a parent/guardian in the water within arms reach at all times.
- Children 9 to 11 MUST have a parent/guardian who is 18 years of age or older at the facility at all times.
- Those requiring a lifejacket MUST always have a parent/guardian in the water within arms reach at all times.
- Pool Staff reserve the right to swim test any person that appears to be a non-swimmer and require to use a lifejacket.



FLOATATION DEVICES & WATER TOYS

- Water wings, floaties, and inflatables are prohibited.
- Coast guards approved lifejackets are allowed. Lifejackets are available for use at the facility if needed.
- Dive rings, masks, fins, snorkels, and goggles are allowed when appropriate. Pool staff may deem equipment unsafe, and participants will not be able to use them at the pool facility.
- Deep Water Swim Requirements - Children 11 and under must be able to complete the swim test before going into the deep end of the pool. Pool Staff will perform the swim test and have the ultimate say in their eligibility in passing or not passing.

LOCKER ROOMS USE

- Children 6 and older must use their same gender locker room.
- Family changing restrooms or single use restrooms are available.
- Please help us conserve water and keep showers brief.
- No food, drink, gum, or glass are allowed in the locker rooms.
- No cell phones or photo device usage allowed in the locker rooms.
- Restrooms/Locker Rooms are available for customers only, no public use available.



SLIDE RULES

- Must be at least 48" tall to go down the slide, or be able to pass a swim test.
- One person allowed at a time.
- Feet first only and must go down on back, no flipping around. Do not attempt to stop in the slide or climb up it.
- 1 person on top platform, 1 person on the middle platform, and all other users must wait at the bottom of the stairs.
- No lifejackets, goggles, or water shoes are allowed down the slide.
- Users must exit the slide zone area immediately after use. Keep slide zone clear, no lingering.
- Weight limit capacity is 250 lbs.
- WARNING: Water depth is 4 feet.



ELLA REDKEY POOL STAFF RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE WHO IS HOSTILE, AGGRESSIVE, OR APPEARS UNDER THE INFLUENCE. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO POOL FACILITY AND SAFETY RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE FACILITY.



WHISTLE COMMUNICATION

- One short whistle blast means a lifeguard is trying to get your attention.
- One long whistle blast means clear the pool.
- Two or three whistle blasts means an emergency is happening.
