### **Important Information about the Written Test**

The Klamath Falls Police Department will conduct an entry-level Police Officer written test that measures critical job skills such as reading, math, writing and grammar skills, reasoning, critical thinking, etc.

To assist in preparing for the written examination candidates are strongly advised to print the Reading Comprehension Manual free of charge to study and memorize. Twenty questions in the written test cover this reading material.
