Public Works crews will be performing work (**weather permitting**) during the week of November 13, 2017, as follows:

WATER

Water Division Crews will be working on underground infrastructure on 11/14 and 11/15. 8th Street will be closed between Main and Pine Street during working hours. The roadway will be opened up Tuesday evening to traffic.

WASTEWATER COLLECTIONS

Crews will continue sewer line cleaning in the presidents streets and Pacific Terrace areas. They will also be televising lines in the North Hills area.

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

While the below information is not a City project we would like citizens to know of the traffic changes, lane and sidewalk closures:

The City has issued an obstruction permit to Wright Tree Service. A detail of lane and street closures and times of closures is attached to this press release.

Traffic control Wright Tree Service 11/13/17

7:30 to 9:30 work will be on Beihn Street between Van ness and East Lowell. A portion of west lane heading south will be closed and directed by flaggers.

9:30 to 11:30 work will be on Oregon Ave between Lakeview and Harriman a portion of the South lane headed east will be closed and directed by flaggers.

12:30 to 2:00 work will be on Siskiyou Ave between Trinity and Delta. A portion of the west lane heading south will be closed and directed by flaggers.

2:15 to 3:30 work will be on California Ave. between Upham and Cook. East side lane heading north will be closed and directed by flaggers.

All sidewalks will remain open and shall have a spotter on site to ensure the safety of pedestrians.
